Glossary of Terms

Conflict of Interest- Circumstances create a conflict of interest when an individual has an opportunity to affect continuing education content about products or services of a commercial interest with which he/she has a financial relationship.

Commercial Interest- Any entity producing, marketing, re-selling, or distributing healthcare goods or services consumed by, or used on, patients. Providers of clinical service directly to patients are not considered to be commercial interests.

Financial Relationships- Those relationships in which the individual benefits by receiving a salary, royalty, intellectual property rights, consulting fee, honoraria for promotional speakers' bureau, ownership interest (e.g., stocks, stock options or other ownership interest, excluding diversified mutual funds), or other financial benefit. Financial benefits are usually associated with roles such as employment, management position, independent contractor (including contracted research), consulting, speaking and teaching, membership on advisory committees or review panels, board membership, and other activities for which remuneration is received, or expected. Relevant financial relationships would include those within the past 12 months of the person involved in the activity and a spouse or partner.

Dr. Casamassimo received his dental degree from Georgetown University in 1974 and a Master of Science and Certificate in Pediatric Dentistry from the University of Iowa in 1976. He has taught at the University of Iowa College of Dentistry (1976-78) and the University of Colorado School of Dentistry (1978-88). He is Editor Emeritus of the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry (AAPD) and its journal, *Pediatric Dentistry*, and also a past-president of the specialty of pediatric dentistry. Dr. Casamassimo is a past-president of the Academy of Dentistry for the Handicapped and past editor of the *Journal of Dentistry for the Handicapped*. He is past editor of the *Journal of Dentistry for Children*.

He has authored or edited over 500 publications in the areas of pediatric dentistry, care of persons with special health care needs, and dental education, including 3 books. His research interests include oral health of children and adults with special health care needs, health services research, and oral health disparity and he has received numerous private and public grants and contracts.

He is a member of a number of professional organizations including the American Dental Association (ADA), as well as Omicron Kappa Upsilon honor fraternity and AAPD. Dr. Casamassimo is a fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons (Edinburgh) and the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry.

Dr. Casamassimo was the 2002 recipient of the AAPD Distinguished Service Award and in 2003, was honored by the Ohio Dental Association with its Humanitarian Award. In 2006, he received the Merle C. Hunter Award for Service from AAPD and in 2007, the AAPD Manuel Album Award for his work with patients with special needs. He is a 2007 recipient of Nationwide Children's Hospital Career Contribution Award. In 2012, he was named Pediatric Dentist of the Year by the AAPD. In 2016, he was named Ron Bell Mentor of the Year by the College of Diplomates of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry. In 2017 he was the Ohio Dental Association's Distinguished Dentist and was awarded the ADA's annual Norton M. Ross Award for Clinical Research. In 2021, he received a Presidential Citation from the AAPD.

Dr. Casamassimo is board-certified in pediatric dentistry and is an attending dentist at Nationwide Children's Hospital where he served as president of the medical staff in 1999. He is a Past-President of the Ohio Dental Association and currently Chief Policy Officer of the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry in Chicago, Illinois. He is currently serves the Ohio State Medicaid Program as a policy consultant and its only dentist, and he was chosen as one of six section editors for the upcoming second *US Surgeon General's Report on Oral Health, 2020*. He is chair-elect of the ADA's Dental Quality Alliance.

He and his wife, Maureen, are proud parents of three children and grandparents to five grandchildren and have resided in Columbus, Ohio, since 1988.
